We have appointed a firm of Planning Consultants who specialise in neighbourhood planning to advise us on the intricacies of compiling a

Our Open Event, held in the West Horsley Village Hall, at the end of November was very well attended and gave the opportunity to feedback the results of the 2015 Residents Survey and to display the emerging themes that are important to the village. This feedback will form an important foundation on which to build the Neighbourhood Plan in line with latest guidance. It also helps demonstrate the degree of engagement of village residents which is a significant component in the Planning Inspectorate's appraisal of our Plan.
